NOTEWORTH SIGHTINGS:

Osprey - one on the Currie Ranch near Lake Tanglewood Aug. 20 (RC). This is the earliest sighting on record. Ruby-crowned Kinglet - one in Amerillo during the first week of August (NE) -Chimney Swift - 500+ congregated at a chimney at the school house in Maimi, Roberts Co. (RB) - this is the largest concentration ever reported in the Panhandle.

Cattle Egret - 150+ in Bates Canyon, Lake Meredith OCt. 6 (FC) - this is the largest concentration ever reported in the Panhandle.
