## Bird Records

Common Loon - one Lake Meredith 10/19 (FC) early date.

White Pelican - six at BLNWR - 10/11 (KS)

Double Crested Cormorant - another species unusually common this fall. Elysian Fields, six 10/1 (KS); Buffalo Lake NWR, six 10/11, two on 10/15 (KS) at Lake Meredith - one on 11/2 (KS).

Greater White fronted Goose - 95 on a playa between Umbarger and Buffalo Lake NWR 10/2 (KS) an unsusally large number to see at one time in this area.

Wood Duck - three males and a female Currie Ranch 10/3 (KS)

Common Merganser - 1 - F at EF - 10/1 (KS) early date.

Osprey - EF - late Sept (TJ) 2 Currie Ranch 10/3 (KS) 1-BLNWR-10/11 1-LAMR 10/19 (FC)

Bald Eagle - 1 - 1 MM near Spearman, 9/26 (FS) very early.

Broad-Winged Hawk - 1 at 1-1MM 9/30, 1-1MM 10/20 all at BLNWR (KS)

Virginia Rail Calling - Currie Ranch 10/3 (KS)

Marbled Godeirt - 1-EF (KS) 10/9

Pictoral Sandpiper - 1 - Tradewinds Playa 10/30 (KS) late.

Black Hooded Parakeet - 1 reported at 5223 Floyd St. 10/13 confirmed (RR). This is a South American species that is widely reported in this country as an escapee. It has even formed small colonies in some areas.

Brown Swallow - large numbers have been reported throughout the area this fall and on later than usual dates. Between 8-9am 10/15, a continuous stream of swallows was observed coming in to BLNWR on the winds of the season's first brisk cold front. An estimated 2,000 birds assembled before dispersing later in the morning. (KS) 150+ were seen again at the lake on 10/20 (KS).

American Crow - a large movement of crows took place across the area between 10/9 and 10/20 all moving to the southwest. Flocks of 50-100 birds each were observed on 10/9 and later. On 10/11 an estimated 500+ moved thru BLNWR.

Winter Wren - 1 BLNWR - 10/11 (KS) - 10/28 (KS-PA)

White Breasted Nuthatch - L. Meredith 11/2 (KS)

Tennessee Warbler - 1 Amarillo - 9/28 (RR)

Townsend's Warbler - this continues to be a Town end's warbler year: An imm. bird was seen at BL 10/2 and a male & fem le on the Currie Ranch 10/3 (KS)

Black throadted green - male & female BLNWR - 10/11 (KS)

Le Conte's Sparrow - the sixth reported sighting of this sparrow in our area since 1936. One at BL 10/2 (KS) - This little jewel was flushed from the grass grown roadside near the old concessionaire's building and it perched, fully exposed and at length in a dead sunflower plant about 10 yards from the observer. One of those real lucky occurrances as most of the little sparrows that fly up from underfoot keep flying and are never seen again.

White winged crossbill - an imm. at BL 10/28 (PA-KS) - This was a "probable" sighting not a "positive". It was seen very briefly, white wing-bars conspicuous and it flew directly over the observers calling briefly. If identified correctly, the third sighting for Texas, second for the Panhandle (KS-PA).
