Bird Sightings, October 1 - December 8, 1987 (Texas Panhandle):
Western Grebe - one on the Palo Duro Club lake near Canyon, Randall Co.
October 25, George and Esther Waddil

Peregrine Falcon - one at Buffalo Lake NWR October 10 (Peggy Acord and Rosemary Scott).

Whooping Crane - a first year bird on a playa near Amarillo, Randall Co. November to end of period. Banding shows it to be a bird hatched in the Wood Buffalo Park in northern Canada. Somehow it got separated from the parent birds that are said to be already in Aransas.

Sanderling - one on the sewage ponds near Amarillo, Randall Co. October 3, (KS)

Red-bellied Woodpecker- one in Palo Duro Canyon SP November 4. (KS)

Red-naped Sapsucker - male birds at Buffalo Lake NWR October 4 an 7, and one in the Palo Duro Canyon SP November 4 and 11. (KS)

Barn Swallow - one a Buffalo Lake November 6 (KS) - a very late bird and the first reported November sighting.

Carolina Wren - two singing birds at Lake Tanglewood, Randall Co. October 14. (KS)

Wood Thrush -one in her back yard in SW Amarillo November 10. (Rosemary Scott) - a rare sighting at any time and most certainly so this late in the year.

Gray Catbird - one in her back yard in SW Amarillo November 12 to the end of period (Rosemary Scott) and one in the Palo Duro Canyon SP November 24. (KS)

Palm Warbler - one of the yellow eastern race at Buffalo NWR October 28(KS)

Black-headed Grosbeak - ten at Lake Tanglewood, Randall Co. November 7.

Tom Johnson. Very noteworthy as our previous reported late date was

October 3.

Brewer's Sparrow - two in the Palo Duro Canyon SP November 24 - this species is rarely reported in the Panhandle.(KS)

Fox Sparrow - one in the Palo Duro Canyon SP November 24, and two at Buffalo Lake NWR November 28. (KS)

Red Crossbill - a male in west Amarillo November 21 and 23. (Peggy Acord)

Evening Grosbeak - scattered sightings at various locations beginning with

one at Buffalo Lake NWR on the early date of October 18 (KS)
Rusty Blackbird - rwelve at Buffalo Lake NWR December 5 (KS)

Lesser Golden Plover - one at Buffalo Lake NWR December 5 (KS). The latest date on record and the only December sighting.
