This checklist was prepared by Barrett W. Pierce and Kenneth Seyffert from the records of the Texas Panhandle Audubon Society (since 1950) and the Panhandle Bird Club (since 1995).

This list includes 391 species of birds whose occurrence in the Texas Panhandle have been verified and accepted by the Texas Panhandle Audubon Society. The Texas Panhandle includes the 26 northernmost counties of Texas. Taxonomy and nomenclature conform to the American Ornithologists Union's checklist of North American Birds (1998, 7th edition) and revisions.

Birds of the Texas Panhandle, published by the Texas Panhandle Audubon Society in 2011 as its 4th Edition, provides additional occurrence information by quadrant of the Panhandle and by month for species listed in this checklist, as well as additional presumptive sightings.

Both editions -- this Field Checklist and the Birds of the Texas Panhandle -- are in print, and available from the Texas Panhandle Audubon Society.
